Karen Bogues welcomed the attendees. Self-introductions were made. The meeting summaries for October and November were approved unanimously with one spelling change made to the November summary.

**Results-Based Accountability/HSAC Activities**

Discussion ensued regarding the recent efforts in the community to evaluate the RBA model for use in our community and the Human Services Advisory Council's efforts to transform their process into a systems approach.

**SCOPE Update**

Allison Pinto described the "place-based initiative" that SCOPE is considering. She discussed the history of this initiative and how it is being used in other communities across the United States.

She explained that, for a whole community to change, there are 4 domains that will need to be considered:

- Community building – If things are going to get better, a lot has to do with how people relate to each other. Are the people who live in this place taking up leadership roles of their own volition or are outsiders being sought to lead? Are people connected with one another with a sense of community and belonging? (civic engagement)
- Programs and services – Things relating to public housing, economics, and services to make life better.
- Policy and systems – What are all the policies that affect life here? Are there partnerships between the residents and the governments, funders, etc? An important part of this domain is fiscal. Without funding, it all falls apart.
- Data – In communities that take this approach, community report cards are often found in addition to other data gathering efforts relating to programs intended to generate change in the community.
