2004 Communities That Care (CTC) High School Survey

Chip Taylor presented the group with the risk and protective factors benchmarks spreadsheet that has been color coded to denote current status. Since these spreadsheets provide much more information, the consensus of the group was to shrink these pages to letter size and insert them in the Community Outcome Targets document in place of those used last year.

Chip advised the group that the CTC survey had been sold to another vendor by Channing-Bete. This is good news for us in that we will be able to continue to use this tool to establish benchmarks and measure progress in the future.

Discussion ensued regarding the outcome targets for which the data is collected using the CTC survey. The following targets were discussed:

- Attacking someone with intent to harm
- Adolescents not using alcohol
- Adolescents not engaged in binge drinking
- Adolescents not drunk or high at school
- Adolescents not using marijuana

These targets were updated based on the analysis found in the Youth Survey Report and will be found in the updated Community Outcome Targets document (attached).

The committee discussed changing the targets and adding new targets. Based on the information gathered, the consensus of the group was that no targets needed to be changed or added.
